This CD Player is accompanied by a long list of notable technical details which guarantee an outstanding sonic quality.

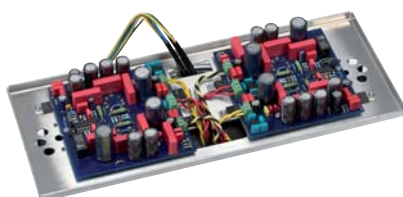
The powerful low impedance output stage with four 6N30 tubes in a balanced configuration has an extremely wide and

linear bandwidth with a signal to noise ratio better than 100 dB. The Philips CDM 2 Pro transport mechanism is one of the highest quality transports available and a 24 bit D/A converter with a 192 KHz sampling rate guarantees the highest resolution possible.
